



As part of annual celebrations, JKR Astro Research Foundation, Hyderabad had organised national astrological seminar on 28th August 2016, at the prestigious Ravindra Bharati auditorium, Hyderabad. It was an event organised on a grand scale, covered extensively by print and electronic media, and astro enthusiasts in excess of thousand people, participated in the seminar. The seminar was inaugurated by DR.R.V.Chandravadan, IAS, GOVERNMENT OF TELENGANA, Dr. BVK Sastry, Chancellor of Yoga Samskrutham university, State of Florida, USA and Dr.C.V.R. Murthy, Director, IIT, Jodhpur were the guests of honour who added grace to the event by their distinguished presence and intellectually stimulating lectures on role of astrology in societal development.

Before the actual seminar started leading lights of astro domain were duly honored. The honour list included scholars from Delhi, Ahmedabad, Chennai, Bangalore. For the first time, a new initiative was taken up by the foundation to receive recommendations from local forum to recognise and honour distinguished astrologers who had contributed to needs of local community over the vears and generation. When the seminar started, people were treated to inspiring and thought provoking presentation by eminent scholars. Dr. R.Vijayalakshmi, initiated the proceedings with a very informative presentation on Nakshatra Siddhanta. This was followed by a thrilling lecture by Dr.K.S Charak on abdominal disorders and their relationship to planetary positions in a native's chart. It was thrilling because, the good Doctor could relate his findings to astrological concepts that could help doctors to conduct clinical management of body disorders taking right in puts from astrologers.

His talk was well appreciated by many. During the day, a new set of books were released to enrich astro literature, with books in tamil, telugu and kannada languages.
